2010 OUT-MIGRATION REPORT Fauntleroy Creek Steev Ward, Dennis Hinton, and Jack Lawless, volunteer monitors

SUMMARY

We documented a total of 24 live coho smolts headed for nearshore habitat in Fauntleroy Cove, more than the past two years and more than the average to date. Total body length was longer than the average to date. The number of trapped live fry was up from last year. We did not find any other aquatic species in the trap.

METHODOLOGY

Our wooden box fitted with netting is anchored below a weir due upstream of the fish ladder in the lower creek. It softly traps everything headed downstream. We checked it almost daily during the monitoring period and released all live fish to continue their journey. Our standard measurement is total length - body including tail fin.
