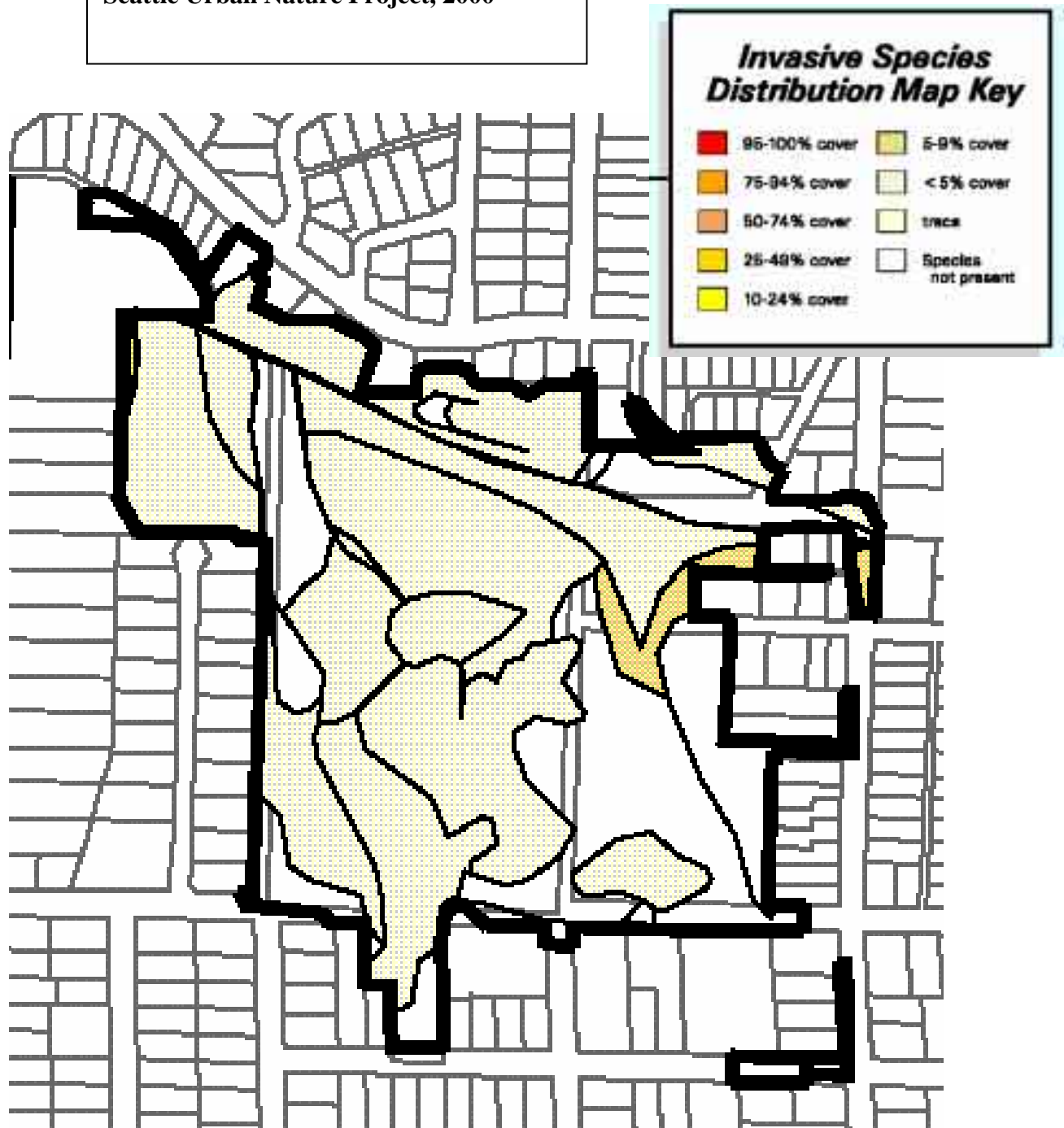

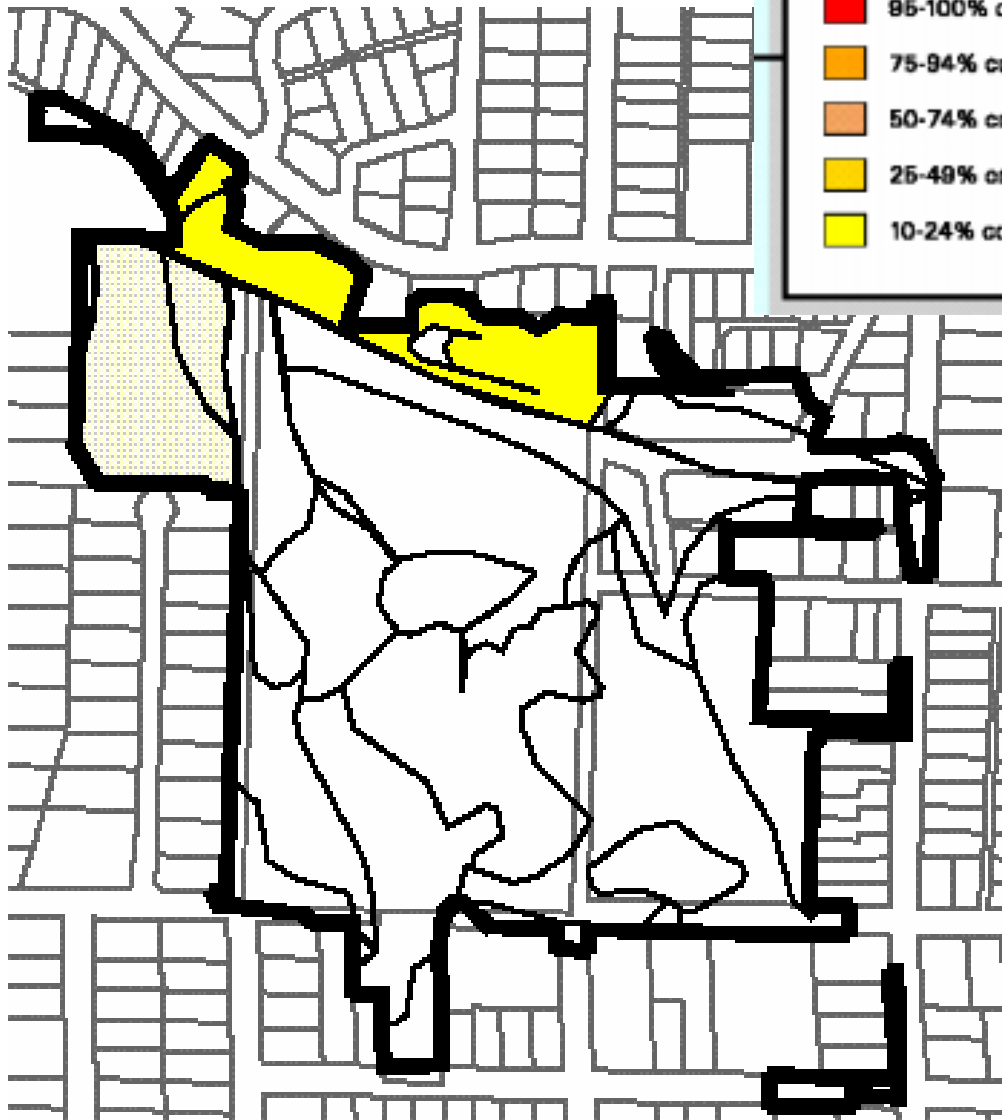


Cherry laurel distribution

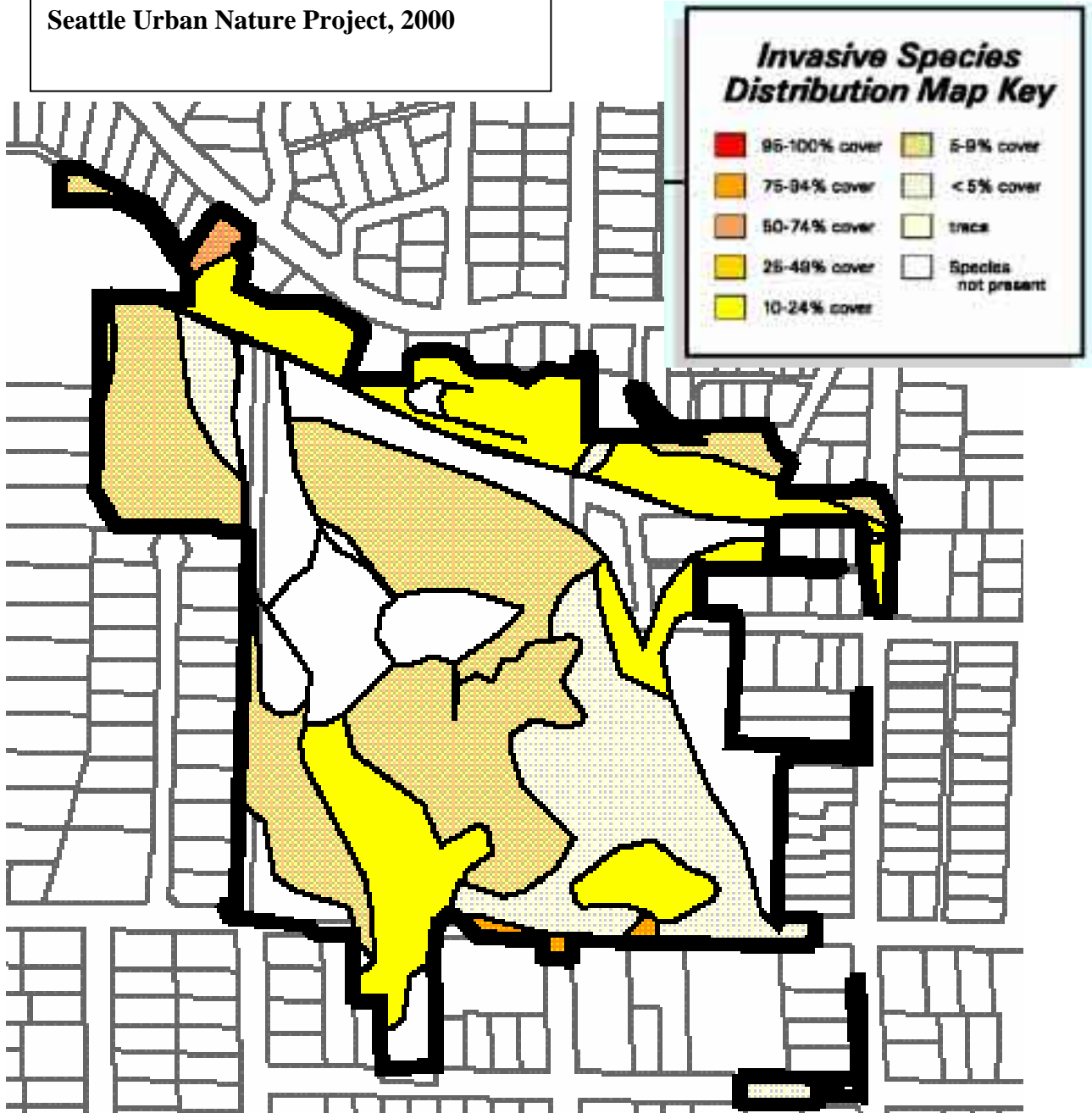

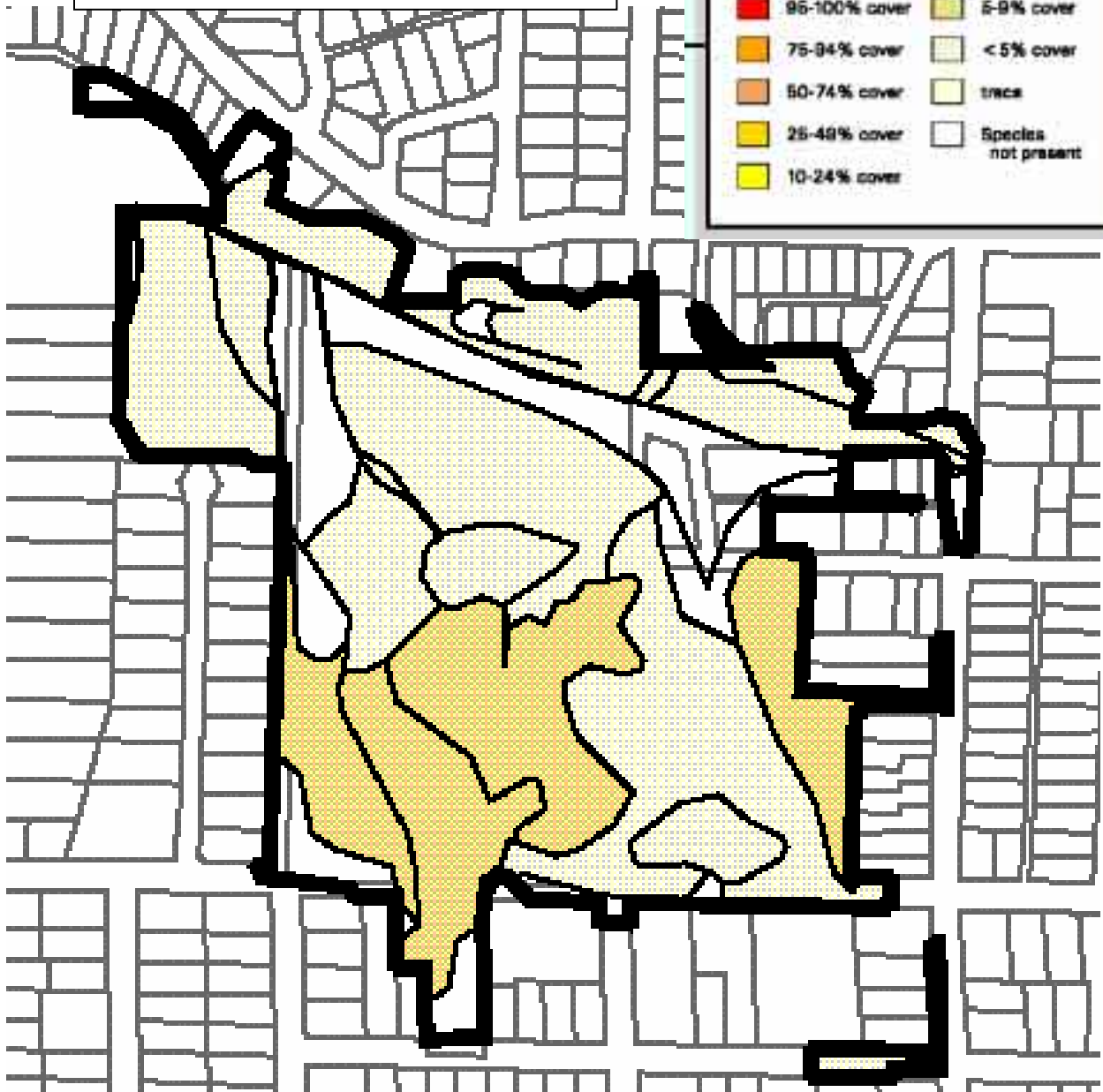
Clematis sp. distribution

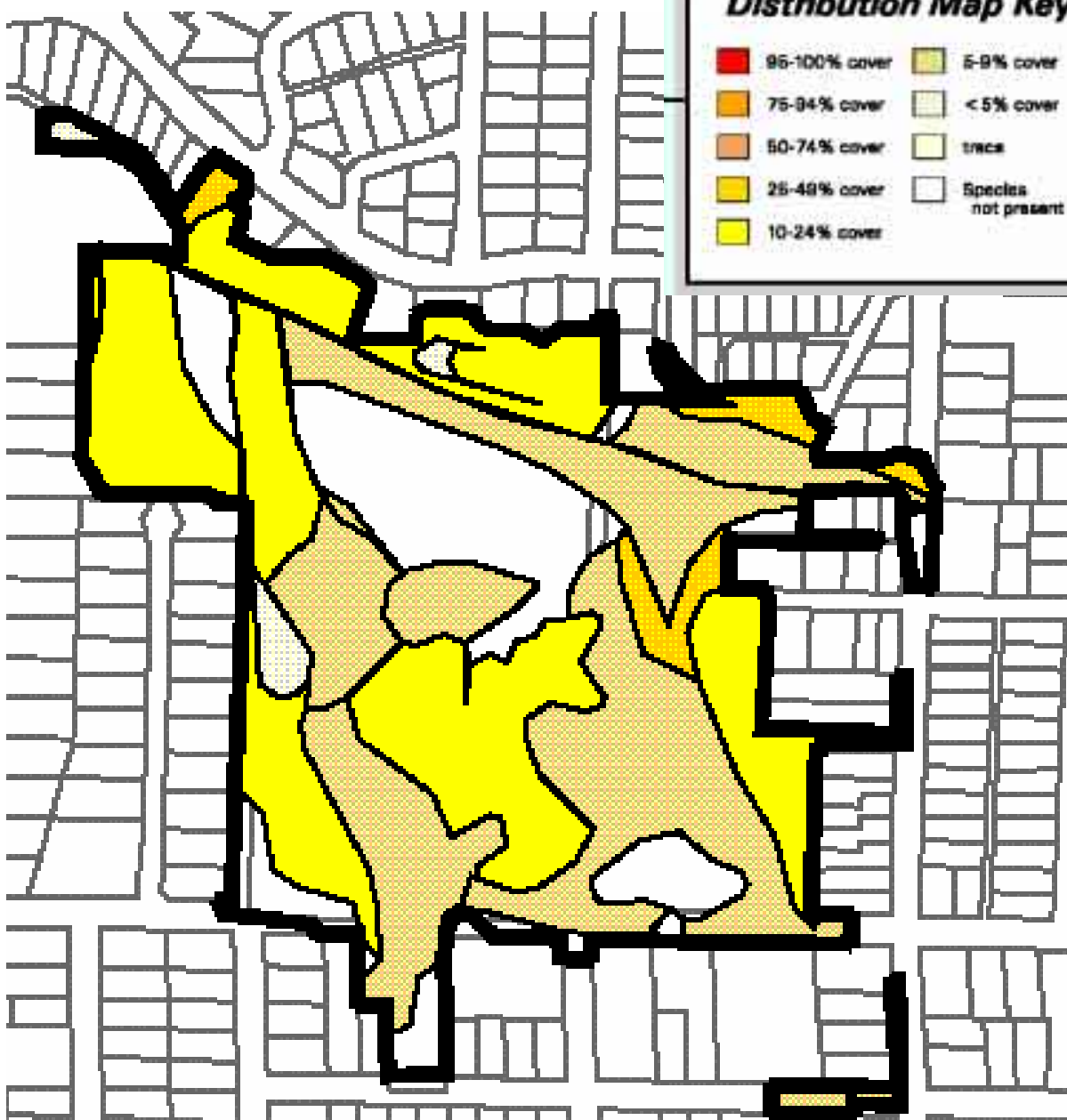
Himalayan blackberry distribution
